#### James 1 (27 Verses)

1. **James**, a **bondservant** of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, To the **twelve tribes** which are **scattered abroad**: **Greetings**.

2. <u>My brethren, c</u>ount it all joy when you fall into various trials,

3. <u>knowing that the **testing** of your faith **produces** patience.</u>

4. <u>But let patience have its perfect work</u>, that you may be perfect and **complete**, **lacking nothing**.

5. <u>If any of you lacks</u> wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all **liberally** and without **reproach**, and it will be **given** to him.

6. <u>But let him</u> ask in faith, with no **doubting**, for he who **doubts** is like a **wave** of the sea driven and **tossed** by the **wind**.

7. *For l*et not that man **suppose** that he will receive **anything** from the Lord;

8. <u>he</u> is a double-minded man, **unstable** in all his **ways**.

9. <u>Let the lowly brother glory in his exaltation</u>,

10. *but the r*ich in his **humiliation**, because as a flower of the **field** he will **pass** away.

11. <u>For no</u> sooner has the sun risen with a burning heat than it withers the grass; its flower falls, and its beautiful appearance perishes. So the rich man also will fade away in his pursuits.

12. <u>Bl</u>essed is the man who endures **temptation**; for when he has been **approved**, he will receive the **crown** of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.

13. <u>Let n</u>o one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself **tempt** anyone.

3. <u>You ask</u> and do not receive, because you ask **amiss**, that you may spend it on your **pleasures**.

4. <u>Adulterers</u> and **adulteresses**! Do you not know that **friendship** with the world is **enmity** with God? Whoever therefore **wants** to be a friend of the world **makes** himself an **enemy** of God.

5. <u>Or</u> do you **think** that the Scripture says in **vain**, "The Spirit who **dwells** in us **yearns jealously**"?

6. <u>But He gives more grace</u>. Therefore He says: "God **resists** the **proud**, But gives grace to the humble."

8. <u>whom</u> having not seen you love. Though now you do not see Him, yet **believing**, you rejoice with joy **inexpressible** and full of glory,

9. <u>*receiving*</u> the end of your faith - the salvation of your souls.
